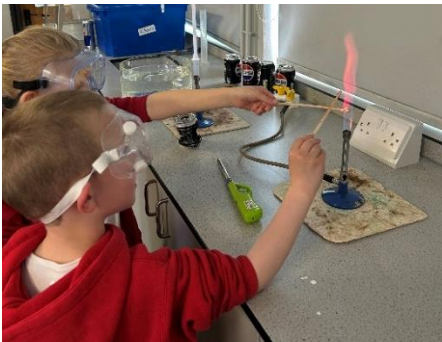
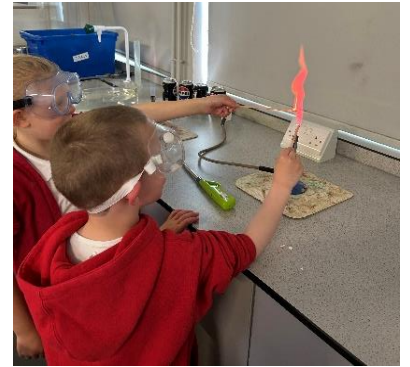
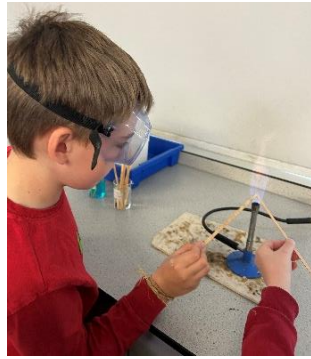
### South Peaks Sports Tournament and Bunting Cup
