It doesn't seem possible that we will soon have completed the first half term of learning! The children have been working very hard in all of their classes and it's been a pleasure to walk around school and see them at work.

Often parents ask me what the best thing they can do to help their children's learning. My answer is simple: read with them! Reading opens so many doors and learning opportunities to the children: it exposes them to new vocabulary; it teaches them about ways of life and places that are different from their own; it gives them a lifelong skill that will be relevant across the curriculum and not just in English.

Younger children may benefit from the sounding out new words model with an adult alongside; whereas with older children you may check in with them from time to time about what has happened, what the themes of the text are or predicting what may come next. The last thing we want is for it to be a chore, but it is a really good way of interacting with your child about their learning.

Thank you for all you do to support your child with their learning; especially in reading.
