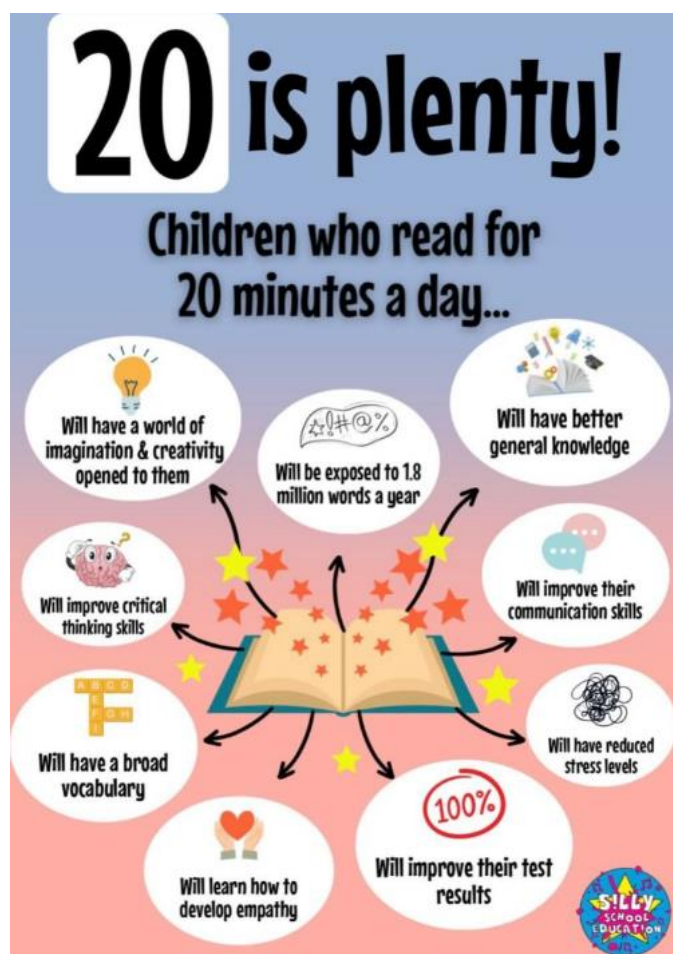
## Meet Mrs Beaumont
